How to use this pack

This pack contains a series of sample lessons, artefact factsheets and a DVD of film clips for use with KS3 and KS4. These can be used to deliver the suggested lessons or can function as stand-alone resources within the wider curriculum.

As with all sex and relationships work, staff delivering the sessions should ensure that they are prepared for any potential disclosures or students requiring additional support. Staff should ensure that they know the correct routes for signposting such students to appropriate services and that any safeguarding concerns are escalated in line with the SWCPP.

Revealing Collections

During 2010-11, The Royal Cornwall Museum (RCM) worked with local young people on the *Revealing Collections* project to investigate both RCM's and The Science Museum's sex-related collections.

Exploring the objects of cultures distant in time and space from our own revealed a wide variety of sexual attitudes and practices. This prompted lively discussions about contemporary sexual issues and we hope this pack will help you do the same.

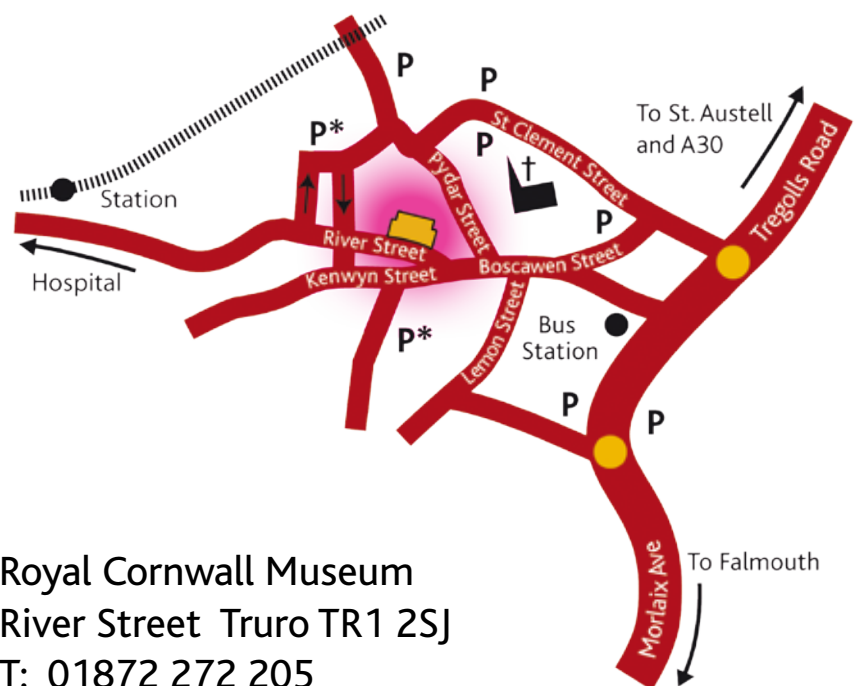
